### A checklist for preparing an article for submission.

As part of the submission process, authors must ensure their article meets all of the following points. Articles that do not meet these requirements may be returned to the authors.

1.	The article is the author's original research and does not contain plagiarism, including that hidden through various technical methods.	
2.	The article has not been previously published in other publications.	

3.	The article is not under consideration by other publications.	
4.	References to borrowings from previously published works of the author (co-authors) have been added to the list of references.	
5.	If the article is part of the author's dissertation research, this is clearly stated at the beginning of the article and in the abstract.	
6.	The article has been checked for plagiarism. The article's originality is greater than 70-80%. All citations are referenced.	
7.	All data on the author/co-authors is filled out completely in Russian.	
8.	All data on the author/co-authors is filled out completely in English.	
9.	The title of the article reflects its content and does not contain any abbreviations.	
10.	Annotatsiya otrazhayet sodержaniye stat'i. Upotreblyayutsya vyrazheniya «Avtorom (ami) predstavlen...», «V stat'ye ...» i t.d.  Na russkom yazyke  Na angliyskom yazyke	
11.	Key words reflect the content of the article: (at least 7-10) Na russkom yazyke  Na angliyskom yazyke	
12.	The text size of an article is from 12 to 20 pages. The article size is calculated without taking into account metadata, i.e. without information about the authors, and the list of references - only the text of the article.	
13.	All abbreviations and acronyms are deciphered upon first use.	
14.	The text of the article contains LINKS to tables, figures, and graphs. Their captions have been translated into English.	
15.	All figures and tables are numbered. All tables, figures, and photographs are referenced (if borrowed) or marked "Compiled (developed) by the author."	
16.	The list of references is prepared in strict accordance with GOST R 7.05-2008.	
17.	All sources are referenced in the text of the article in square brackets. [ ]	
18.	Sources are listed in the reference list in the order they are mentioned in the text. NOT alphabetically!	
19.	References to laws, standards (including GOSTs), articles from dictionaries and encyclopedias, website pages for which a specific author is NOT indicated, and other similar materials are formatted as footnotes throughout the text of the article.	
20.	The reference list must include 10 or more titles. For a REVIEW or THEORETICAL article, it must include more than 20 titles, at least 30% of which are foreign sources.
